  - c. Revise the Storage and Disposal statement so that:
    1. The subheading "Pesticide Disposal:" appears before the sentence "Open dumping is prohibited."
    2. The subheading "Container Disposal:" appears before the statement beginning with the phrase "Triple rinse (or equivalent) . . ."

- 3. The last sentence of the Storage and Disposal statement reads as follows: "Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then, offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."
  - d. Insert the following sentence in the Precautionary Statements, after the sentence "Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.": "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
  - e. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to read as follows: "Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SURFACE SPRAYING.** This spray provides rapid initial kill of exposed or accessible stages of the following insects: granary weevil, rice weevil, confused flour beetle, rust-red flour beetle, cadelle, sawtoothed grain beetle, spider beetle, cheese mites and grain mites. Apply as a coarse droplet spray using the following application rate.

APPROXIMATE USE RATE

Spray	Area To Be Covered
1 Pint	93 3/4 square feet
1 Quart	187 1/2 square feet
1 Gallon	750 square feet

Spray walls, floors and other surfaces of bins and storage and handling areas thoroughly being especially careful to treat cracks, crevices and similar hiding places. Treat unloading, handling and processing areas and inside conveying processing and handling equipment. Spray thoroughly around the base of heavy machinery and equipment. Spray insects directly when possible. For in-transit protection, clean and spray truck beds, boxcars and ships' holds before loading. Thoroughly treat walls and floors and spray each layer of cartons and containers lightly as stacked.

To control Indian meal moth and Angoumois grain moth in stored grain, apply to the surface of binned grain at the following application rate:

APPROXIMATE USE RATE

1 Quart	250 square feet
1 Gallon	1,000 square feet

Apply at monthly intervals with the first appearance of moths and continue until early fall. In case of severe infestations, break up webbing with rake before spraying and make a second application in two weeks.

As an aid in the control of mosquitoes, gnats, wasps and skippers, treat walls, ceilings, moldings, screens, door and window frames, beams, light cords and similar resting places.

**SPACE SPRAYING:** To control flies, mosquitoes, gnats and flying moths, close windows, doors and other ventilation. Using a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist, direct spray toward the upper portions of the enclosure. Distribute spray throughout the entire area using 1/2 ounce spray per 1000 cubic feet of space. To control active exposed stages of running and crawling insects previously named, direct mist toward and into all places commonly inhabited by these insects, using a rate of 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least 10 minutes after spraying. Vacate premises and ventilate before reoccupying.

**FOGGING:** This oil base spray is suitable for application using conventional, thermal, mechanical or compressed air fogging equipment. Use as directed under "Space Spraying" filling the entire area with mist at a rate of 2 to 4 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space, to control exposed or accessible stages of any insects named on this label.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place. Consult Federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.
