

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

CORROSIVE Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. May be harmful if swallowed. Wash hands after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink plenty of water. Large quantity of milk, egg whites, or oil if these are not available. Drink larger quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN Possible mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or residue that cannot be used should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is highly toxic to fish and aquatic life. Do not discharge into streams, rivers, or other bodies of water. Do not discharge into the ground. Do not discharge into the air. Do not discharge into the water supply.

PHYSICAL & CHEMICAL HAZARDS: This product is highly flammable. Do not use near open flames or other sources of ignition. Do not use in confined spaces. Do not use in the presence of oxidizing agents. Do not use in the presence of acids.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

FOR DAIRIES, FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT UTENSILS
& OTHER HARD SURFACES IN FOOD CONTACT LOCATIONS

1. Clean surface as usual and rinse thoroughly with potable water
2. Sanitize by circulating or rinsing equipment with a fresh solution of **Acid Sanitizer** at 1 oz. per 4 gallons water, being sure to wet all surfaces thoroughly. This use dilution provides 220 ppm Dodecylbenzenesulfonic acid. Allow surface to drain and air dry.
3. For large surfaces, spray with **Acid Sanitizer** at use dilution, wetting all surfaces thoroughly. Allow surface to drain and air dry.
4. For utensils, immerse in **Acid Sanitizer** at use dilution. Allow utensils to air dry on a rack or drain board.
5. Contact time at use dilution is required for sanitization.
6. The solution of **Acid Sanitizer** at use dilution should not be re-used for sanitizing.
