n-Alkyl (98% C<sub>12</sub>, 2% C<sub>14</sub>)  
dimethyl 1-naphthylmethyl ammonium  
chlorides monohydrate . . . . 4.0%

**DIRECTIONS:** Add to the final rinse  
or sour bath. Use 1½ oz. per 100 lbs. of  
linens (dry weight), or per 20 gallons of  
water.

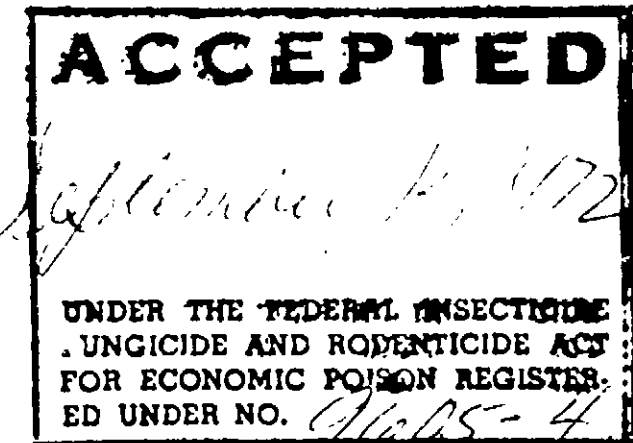

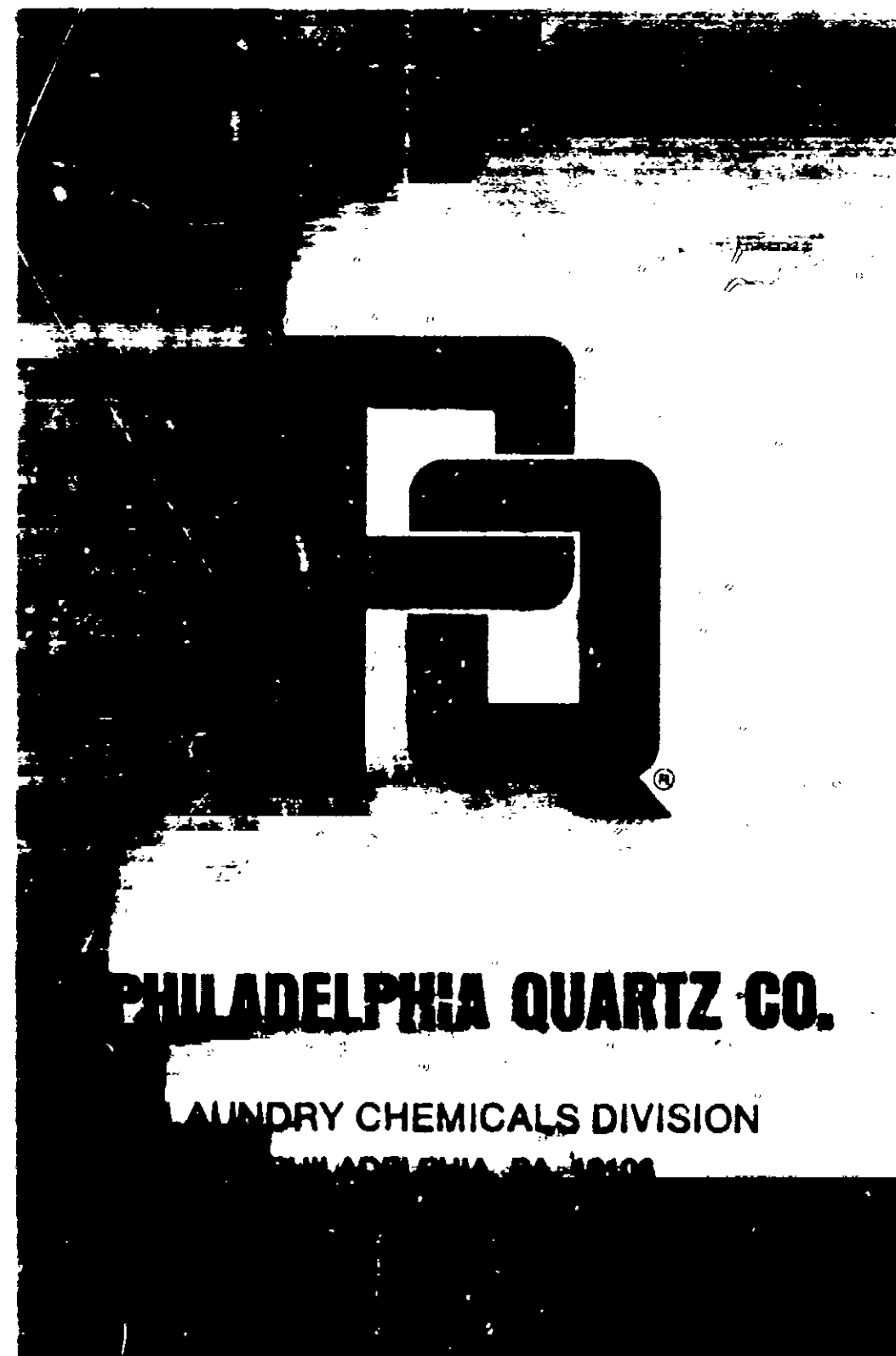

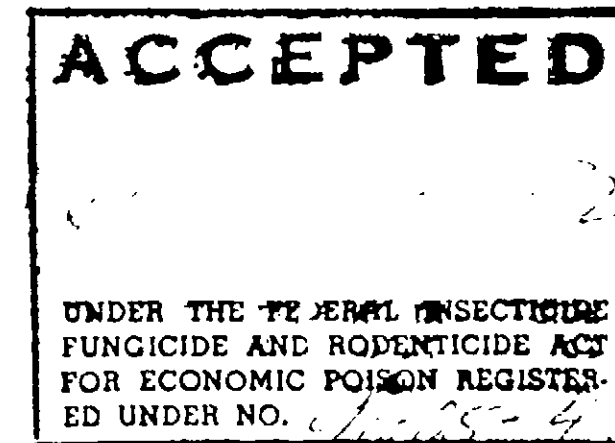
