Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells. Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT

FOOD AND FEED HANDLING ESTABLISHMENT. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices, using a blizzard, duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. SERVING AREAS. Facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. 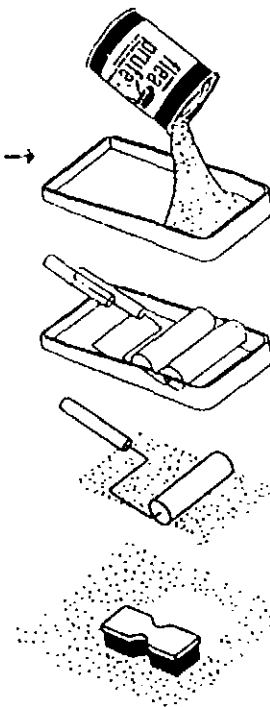

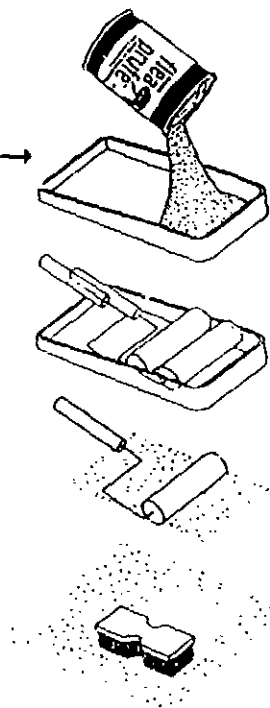
