c. Revise the Statements of Practical Treatment to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.
Drink I or 2 glasses of water and induce
vomiting by touching back of throat with
finger. If person is unconscious, do not
give anything by mouth and do not induce
vomiting.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artifical respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

3. Add the following disclaimer to your product labeling:

This product may be used to impart a temporary resistance at these places of attack which may aid in the prevention of immediate reinfestation. Such applications are not a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment but merely a supplement, particularly where use of other insecticides may pose an order problem.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

Termite Prufe™ is effective for all interior and exterior lumber, plywood, logs, and wood-form composite components. It can be used for <u>infested wood</u> and as a <u>preventive treatment</u> for wood in existing structures, also for <u>pre-treatment</u> during construction. The solution continues to penetrate deep into wood and does not break down, giving long lasting protection.

Directions for use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mixing: (1 lb makes 1 gal. - Covers 200 sq. if.) Fill bucket with about 30% of a gallon of water. While stirring add 1 lb of Termite Prufe powder, then add water to make 1 gal. Stir until dissolved crystal clear, approximately 5 minutes (quicker in warrn water). Note: Stores indefinitely in sealed plastic container. Use duplicate

label enclosed to securely affix to stored solution.

Application equipment: Solution can be applied with paint brush, roller or trigger spray bottle. Garden tank sprayer works best for attics, crawl spaces, decks, fences, logs and new construction.

Application: Wood surface should be clean, dry and unsealed before treating. Apply solution until wood surface is thoroughly wet. Apply second application after 1 to 24 hours. Applications can also be made by drilling approximately 1/4 holes and injecting solution into wood and/or wall voids. Avoid drilling into plumbing and/or spraying electrical installations. Any white residue can be easily removed with warm water and a mild soap solution. Wood should be completely dry (at least 48 hours) before applying paint, varnish or a waterproofing seal. Avoid contact with plant life,

Replacing infested wood: Treat surrounding area and all sides of

new wood with 2 applications before installing.

Pre-treatment during construction: Apply solution to all accessible sufaces of bare wood, plywood and wood-form composite until surface is thoroughly wet. Apply second application after 1 to 24 hours. Apply after roofing and framing are in place and before insulation and dry walls are installed. Protect treated wood from rain.

Note: Correct leaks and moisture exposure that cause infestation, Wood exposed to moisture should be sealed after treatment. Not recommended for portion of wood that is in direct contact with soil. When glueing wood, treat only after glue is dry.

Precautionary statements:


