
At this time we are also adding some minor non-FIFRA language to the label. The added language is detailed in the enclosed highlighted label.

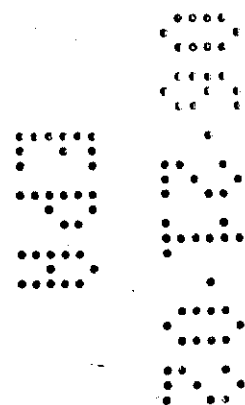

Termite Prufe Ready to Use is effective for all interior and exterior wood. It can be used for infested wood, as a preventive treatment in existing structures and for pre-treatment during construction. The solution continues to penetrate deep into wood and does not breakdown, giving long lasting protection. Larger size is available for use with garden tank sprayer for attics, crawl spaces, decks, fences, logs and new construction.

**Directions for Use:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Application:** Wood surface should be clean, dry and unsealed before treating. Apply solution until wood surface is thoroughly wet. Apply second application after 1 to 24 hours. Use attached extension tube to apply solution directly into termite holes and/or wood and wall voids by drilling 3/32" holes. Avoid drilling into plumbing and/or spraying electrical installations. Wood should be completely dry (at least 48 hours) before applying paint, varnish or a waterproofing seal. Avoid contact with plant life. When replacing unsound wood, treat surrounding area and all sides of new wood with 2 applications before installing. **Note:** Use hot water to flush pump/tube and remove any residue on windows after use. Correct leaks and moisture exposure that cause infestation. Wood exposed to moisture should be sealed after treatment. Not recommended for portion of wood that is in direct contact with soil. When gluing wood, treat only after glue is dry. We recommend a small patch test before general application. Application of this product in food areas of food-handling establishments, other than crack and crevice treatment is not permitted.

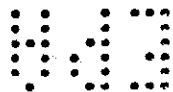
