

BISON-SP-5 Algaecide should be added along pool edges while filter and pump are in operation. To allow time for even distribution in pool water, bathers should allow 10 minutes after treatment before entering pool.

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 25,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 25,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 25,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

BISON-SP-5 Algaecide is efficient, economical and stable in use dilution.
