DIRECTIONS

For Snow Mold Control

Before the ground freezes, or before a heavy snow, apply Once Over Mercurial Fungicide to greens, approaches and collars at the rate of 20# per 1000 sq. ft. Where prolonged snow cover is anticipated, or where mat and thatch are heavy an application of 25# per 1000 sq. ft. will provide better disease protection under these severe conditions. If repeat rains or periods of thawing occur after the initial application, an additional treatment during an open period in mid winter assures added protection. Apply uniformly. Calibrate each spreader to assure accurate distribution of an effective dosage.

Note: Thoroughly wash spreader immediately after use. When this container is empty discard immediately. **DO NOT REUSE.**
