**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GREEN FREE 20 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using GREEN FREE 20. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 36.5 to 56 fluid ounces of GREEN FREE 20 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 20 to 36.5 fluid ounces of GREEN FREE 20 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 6.5 to 13 fluid ounces of GREEN FREE 20 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 4 to 6 fluid ounces of GREEN FREE 20 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially 2 to 4 fluid ounces of GREEN FREE 20 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of GREEN FREE 20 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

GREEN FREE 20 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. GREEN FREE 20 can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix GREEN FREE 20 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Residue that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.

- METAL CONTAINERS:** Triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place.
