The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing of vapor. Do not breathe vapors or mist during brush, roll, spray and dip application. Wear a NIOSH/MHSA-approved mist/vapor respirator when spraying for continued or prolonged use of this product or for frequent use of this product. Use only with adequate ventilation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

2. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement by changing the statement "...estuaries, oceans or public waters..." to read "...estuaries, oceans or other waters..." In addition, change the statement "...previously notifying the sewage treatment..." to read "...previously notifying the local sewage treatment..."

3. Revise the If Swallowed section to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

4. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statement by deleting the word "PROHIBITIONS" from the statement "PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." In addition, move the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." and place it immediately following the heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL."


