The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Since this product is for manufacturing use update the Environmental Hazards Section to read:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

Reinstate: "This product is toxic to fish" in this section.

b. On the front panel you should delete the first of the duplicated Signal Words: "WARNING".

c. Move "Contains Petroleum Distillates" to below the ingredient statement, as a substatement.

d. Move "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" to below the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

e. To the front panel add the referral statement: See side Panel for Additional Precautionary Statements.

f. Add a statement that each formulator is responsible for obtaining EPA registration for his end use product(s).

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Please note that we did not review the labeling for the additional brand name since the label text must be identical to the basic registration except for the brand name.
