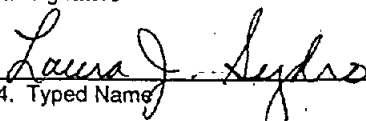

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# WOOD PRESERVATIVE WATER-REPELLANT

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

M-GARD W552 is an emulsifiable concentrate of zinc naphthenate suitable for dilution with water and subsequent application to wood by brush, dip, spray, or pressure impregnation including landscape logs and structural timber, planking, siding, fences, greenhouse wood and stakes, millwork, plywood, shingles, structural logs, wood block flooring and canvas. Treated wood can be used as a staking material for various food plants with no additional precautions. M-GARD W552 will significantly reduce the deterioration of wood or canvas by fungal rot or mildew growth. Wood products are not noticeably discolored by M-GARD W552. Maximum preservation is obtained by full cell pressure treatment, as conducted to obtain an average zinc retention of 0.07 pcf.

### FOR PRESSURE TREATMENT:

Dilute the M-GARD W552 with about 15 to 30 volumes of water, depending on the total net retention. Recirculation of the treating solution should be maintained for best results.

### FOR DIPPING, BRUSHING, OR SPRAYING:

Reduce the M-GARD W552 with about 3 volumes of water. Maintain good agitation in the dip emulsion. Completely immerse for at least 1-2 minutes. The dip emulsion containing 3 volumes of water may also be used for minimal protection by brush and spray treatments. Two coats should be used for best results. Total consumption should be about one gallon per 100 square feet per coat. When painting over M-GARD W552 with oil-borne or water-borne coatings, the wood should be thoroughly dried or sealed with shellac.

### FABRIC AND CORDAGE PROTECTION:

Dilute with 3 volumes of water. Can be used to protect and preserve fabric against mildew, mold and fabric destroying and staining fungus, including rope, twine, canvas, burlap and other fabrics. Material should be thoroughly saturated until wet and air dried before use. Material can be either sprayed or dipped for complete saturation. Do not use on fabric intended for food or feed contact surfaces or clothing. Not for use on fabric or cordage in ground contact situations.
