The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Reinstate the following statements in the Environmental Hazards Section:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when disposing equipment wash waters.

b. On the front panel you should delete the first of the duplicated Signal Words: "WARNING".

c. Move "Contains Petroleum Distillates" to below the ingredient statement, as a substatement.

d. Move "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" to below the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

e. Reinstate: Coverage One gallon covers 100 square feet.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Please note that we did not review the labeling for the additional brand name since the label text must be identical to the basic registration except for the brand name.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
**IF IN EYES:** Hold eyes open and flush with steady gentle stream of water for 15 minutes.  
**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin mixture, or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting as it may cause respiration pneumonia.  
**IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION.

## DIRECTION

For the control of fungal rot and decay, spray, soaked or dipped, saturating the wood. M-GARD WS10 is an emulsifiable concentrate. Dilution and subsequent application to wood impregnation including landscape logs and fences, greenhouse wood and stakes, millwork, wood block flooring, non-appral canvas (tinder, baskets, and lumber for ammunition staking material for various food plants). WS10 will significantly reduce the deterioration, fungal rot, and mildew growth. Wood oil-borne or water-borne coatings can be removed thoroughly or has been sealed with shellac.

**APPLICATION**  
**PRESSURE TREATMENT:** For pressure treatment of water. Recirculation of the treating solution is obtained by full cell pressure. An average copper retention of 0.07 pcf.

**DIP, BRUSH, SPRAY:** When treating by DIP, immerse in solution for 15 minutes. Maintain good agitation in the dip tank, consuming one pint of emulsion per cubic foot of wood. A solution containing two volumes of water may also be used for spray treatment. **FOR BRUSH, SPRAY:** Spray on with repeat applications after the emulsion has dried to provide additional penetration.

**CANVAS, FOUNDATION TIMBERS:** For canvas and foundation timbers, wood should be completely wet. For foundation timbers in contact, wood should be free of bark and penetrated. Dilution ratios are fixed to Federal Specification is involved, the ratio is 1:1.
