The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Reinstate the following statements in the Environmental Hazards Section:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when disposing equipment wash waters.

b. Move "Contains Petroleum Distillates" to below the ingredient statement, as a substatement.

c. Add "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" to below the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

d. Move KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN to close proximity to the Signal Word WARNING. The preferred location is immediately above the Signal Word.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
