The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Reinstate the following statements in the Environmental Hazards Section:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when disposing equipment wash waters.

b. Move "Contains Petroleum Distillates" to below the ingredient statement, as a substatement.

c. On the front panel you should delete the first of the duplicated Signal Words: "WARNING".

d. Move "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" to below the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

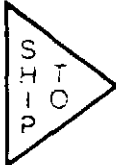

**STORAGE:** Store at temperatures between 0 F and 100 F. If product has been spilled or is leaking, remove the source of the spill or leak. Recover free liquid. Spread absorbent, then pick up and place in containers. Then, where applicable, wash area with detergent and water. Store product in original container only. Do not contaminate fertilizers, food or feed. Keep container close when not in use.

**DIRECTION**  
Treatment of Poles.  
GENERAL

M-GARD POLE-TREAT is a wood preservative that retards rot and mildew on any natural wood surface. This preservative will preserve and protect soil, water or concrete.

**STANDING POLES:** Use M-GARD POLE-TREAT only on poles that are satisfactory for continuous service. The length of treatment to be used is determined by the inspector to be necessary for the region. Scrape away dirt and decayed wood from the bottom of the trench to a predetermined groundline to suit local conditions. Coat with a paper to increase the effectiveness of the product to a suitable wrapping material back-filling the trenched area. For best results, the coating should be less than 30% when the preservative is applied.

**PILING:** Treat the cut-end with a coating 1/16th inch thick.

Poles that have been held in storage for a long period and relocated, may be treated in decay voids described for standing poles, taking care to apply treatment.
