The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Reinstate the following statements in the Environmental Hazards Section:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when disposing equipment wash waters.
 - b. Move "Contains Petroleum Distillates" to below the ingredient statement, as a substatement.
 - c. On the front panel you should delete the first of the duplicated Signal Words: "WARNING".
 - d. Move "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" to below the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE on the top of the right panel. Delete the duplicate heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE at the bottom of the right panel.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Causes skin irritation. Do not get on skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store at temperatures between 0 F and 100 F. If the product has been spilled or is leaking, remove the source of the spill or leak. Recover free liquid. Spread absorbent, then pick up and place in containers. Then, where applicable, wash area with detergent and store product in original container only. Do not store with fertilizers, food or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinseate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed, should be disposed of according to procedures approved by federal, state or local disposal authorities. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Hold eyes open and flush with steady gentle stream of water for 15 minutes.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, and gelatin mixture, or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting as it may cause respiration pneumonia.

DIRECTION

M-GARD F500 is a copper naphthenate based concentration or dilution with various treatment of wood. Wood to be treated - logs, lumber, fenceposts, landscape decks, siding, roof shingles, and stak. Dip and pressure treatment are recommended. M-GARD F500 will protect wood against attack by dry rot and termite attack.

PREPARATION

Wood should be clean and free of dirt and bark.

APPLICATION

DIP, SPRAY OR BRUSH: Use at this existing concentration or dilute to the desired concentration. Immerse wood 1-3 minutes per inch of thickness. For below ground use, immerse in solution. For pressure treatment, immerse in solution or dilute in petroleum solvent down to 100 psi (Copper as metal). Obtain an average coating by pressure treatment.

NOTES TO USER

Do not use on wood intended for food. Wood should be dry, clean, well seasoned and free of preservative. Do not apply on painted or varnished surfaces.

COVER

One gallon covers 100-300 sq. ft. depending on wood type.

DIRECTION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
