WOOD PRESERVATION: For the control of mildew, moss, termites, and other wood products including poles, lumber, foundation sills, docks, boat timbers, bridge timbers, land concrete, or water. M-GARD can be used to maintain preservatives. M-GARD S510 may be used to pre-treat wood in the wood of 0.04 pcf for a minimum of 30 days contact. Specific recommendations for use are given in the ANPA standards. Alternatively, M-GARD S510 can be applied by brushing, spraying, or dipping products for a minimum of 30 days greater absorption of preservative. Limited penetration of these products is limited to field maintenance ground exposure only, unless otherwise permitted complete penetration.

WOOD PREPARATION: Wood should be clean and free of bark. Application of M-GARD S510 with a coating such as paint penetration and protection.

TREATING SOLUTIONS: M-GARD S510 wood, usually in a hydrocarbon solvent, is completely soluble in all hydrocarbon solvents, kerosene and turpentine. M-GARD S510 should be agitated before use. Rate of coverage for brushing is 200 sq. ft. Typically for pre-treatment of M-GARD S510 in the solvent or dipping, a 17X to 20X solvent should be used. NOTE: M-GARD S510 is not a solvent. M-GARD S510 solvent per part of M-GARD S510.
