c. In the Statement of Practical Treatment you should delete the "If Swallowed:" section since this product is in Toxicity Category IV and since it is a water based product it is unlikely to produce respiration pneumonia. Add:

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

3. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
