

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For initial chlorination add one (1) ounce of concentrate for each 5,000 gallons of pool water. Test the chlorine residual with a pool test kit. Repeat initial dosage if necessary until a chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm is obtained. Thereafter, add one (1) ounce of concentrate per 5,000 gallons daily or as needed to maintain

the available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. Higher temperatures or increased bathing loads may require more frequent dosages. Test pool water frequently with a suitable chlorine test kit. Pool water should be maintained at a pH of 7.2 to 7.6 as determined by a test kit.

DANGER

DANGER Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. Keep cover closed when not in use. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin.

Strong oxidizing agent. Contact with heat, moisture, foreign materials, or contamination from any source may result in fire. Moisture contamination may liberate irritating and hazardous chlorine containing gases. Do not mix with other chemicals. Mix only with water. Burning will produce chlorine or equally toxic gases.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Do not con-

taminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

FIRST AID: In case of contact: Externally: Remove excess material by flooding with water. Flush eyes, or skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes get medical attention immediately. Clean contaminated clothing before reuse.

Internally: Drink raw egg white, milk, or rice gruel. Follow with amaranth, tablespoon mustard in glass of water. Call physician.
