

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ALGAWAY is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using ALGAWAY.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 75 to 116 fluid ounces of ALGAWAY per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools cleaned and filled pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of ALGAWAY per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13 to 25 fluid ounces of ALGAWAY per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains having visible algae growth require an initial dose of 8 to 12 fluid ounces of ALGAWAY per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains cleaned and filled, add initially 4 to 8 fluid ounces of ALGAWAY per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces of ALGAWAY per 1000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. ALGAWAY is compatible with those chemicals normally used in swimming pools, spas, and decorative fountains and is effective in maintaining an alkaline pH. ALGAWAY can be used in pools, spas, and decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not use ALGAWAY with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leak-proof containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded. Clean up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in plastic and discard as trash.
