RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS: (Cooling Towers, Evaporative Condensors: - Bacterial Control: Use 0.16 to 1.6 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons water in the system (1.25 to 12.5 ppm) as a continuous or intermittent slug treatment one to three times a week or as required to maintain control. When the system is just noticeably fouled, use 0.58 to 5.8 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons water in the system (4.5 to 45 ppm) daily or as required to obtain control. Badly fouled system must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

Apply at a point in the system where uniform mixing and even distribution will occur, such as the cooling tower basin or sump.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of according to procedures approved by federal, state, or local disposal authorities. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse for equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place.
