is recommended for disinfecting floors, walls, glass, metal, and plastic surfaces, including linens, bath tubs, toilets, and dishes and utensils, bath rooms, laboratory equipment, furniture, posters, and X-ray equipment and other hard surfaces. It is also used for disinfecting linens, linens, OB suites, recovery rooms, scrub rooms, and other areas of hospitals, ambulatory care, patient units, and general hospital environment. The ingredients of HETRACIDE are BIODEGRADABLE.

DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Before disinfecting surfaces with HETRACIDE, remove gross dirt and debris from the surfaces.

Apply 1/2 cup of HETRACIDE to 1 gallon of water, used. Apply to surface with brush or sponge. Rinse thoroughly with water. HETRACIDE is not for use on fabrics or other porous materials. Rinse thoroughly with clean water after use.

Surface treatments may be prepared from 1/2 cup of HETRACIDE per gallon of water.

The recommended use of HETRACIDE is listed in the following table. A.O.A.C. methods 1970, with the exception of the A.O.A.C. Official Methods for Testing of Disinfectants, are available on request.

HETRACIDE is an effective disinfectant for use on surfaces. The following is a list of surfaces for which HETRACIDE is recommended: Bathrooms, patient units, general hospital environment, etc.

DANGER: Keep out of the reach of children.

Corrosive to tissue, causes eye and skin damage. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get on skin or in eyes. Wear goggles or rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. If swallowed, drink promptly a large amount of milk, gelatin solution or water. Call a physician at once.

Do not reuse empty tray. Return to manufacturer for disposal instructions. See label for disposal instructions.
