WASHING PROCEDURE

Follow directions on MYCO MOP label.

TREATMENT PROCEDURE

1. Fill to high water level at 120°F.
2. Add 4 to 5 gallons of MYCO S-45 for every 100 pounds clean weight of load with wheel in motion. Run 5 minutes. Water will clear. Drain.
3. Extract for 2 to 3 minutes in extractor or hydrator.
4. Tumble dry. Mops are now ready for use.
5. The mops should be promptly wrapped to keep them bacteriostatic.
