TOP NR SANITIZER is a colorless and odorless liquid for use in cleaning. For the highest level of disinfection, it should be used at a concentration of 100 ppm. For cleaning purposes, fresh sanitizing solution must be prepared at least daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOOD PROCESSING AREAS: All equipment, food utensils, floors, walls and surfaces which come in contact with food should be thoroughly cleaned and rinsed with potable water prior to application of sanitizer solution. Dilute two (2) ounces of TOP NR SANITIZER per one (1) gallon of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternaries. Apply solution with a cloth, mop, sponge, spray device or by immersion. Sanitizer solution should be allowed to remain on the surface for at least one minute. Drain sanitizer solution from the surface and allow to air dry.

HOUSEKEEPING: For sanitizing and disinfecting floors, walls and inanimate surfaces. For School Locker Rooms, Changing Pails, Sink Tops, Corridors, Classrooms, Offices and Shower Stalls. Apply solution with mop or cloth. Sanitize with 2 ounces of TOP NR SANITIZER per one (1) gallon of water. Disinfect with 4 1/2 ounces of TOP NR SANITIZER to one (1) gallon of water. Kills *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella choleraesuis*. For heavily soiled or contaminated areas, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

HOSPITALS: For floors, walls and other hard surfaces in Nursing Homes, Institutions, as well as Sink Tops, Changing Pails, Telephones and Restrooms, use TOP NR SANITIZER at 5 1/2 ounces per one (1) gallon of water. Apply with cloth, mop or sponge. At this level, TOP NR SANITIZER will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PHD 10. For heavily soiled or contaminated areas, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

DAIRIES: All dairy equipment such as tanks, milking parlors and milk cans, should be cleaned and rinsed thoroughly with potable water prior to application of sanitizer solution. Dilute two (2) ounces of TOP NR SANITIZER per one (1) gallon of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternaries. Apply solution with a cloth, mop, sponge, spray device or by immersion. Sanitizer solution should be allowed to remain on the surface for at least one minute. Drain sanitizer solution from the surface and allow to air dry.

RESTAURANT AND BAR RINSE: Dishes, glassware, silverware and cooking utensils must be cleaned and rinsed thoroughly with potable water prior to application of sanitizer solution. Immerse in a solution of two (2) ounces of TOP NR SANITIZER to one (1) gallon of water (200 ppm active quaternaries). Sanitizer solution should be allowed to remain on the surface for at least one minute. Drain sanitizer solution from the surface and allow to air dry.

This product when used on environmental inanimate hard surfaces at 5 1/2 ounces per one (1) gallon of water is effective against influenza A2, Herpes simplex, Adenovirus type 5 and Vaccinia viruses.
