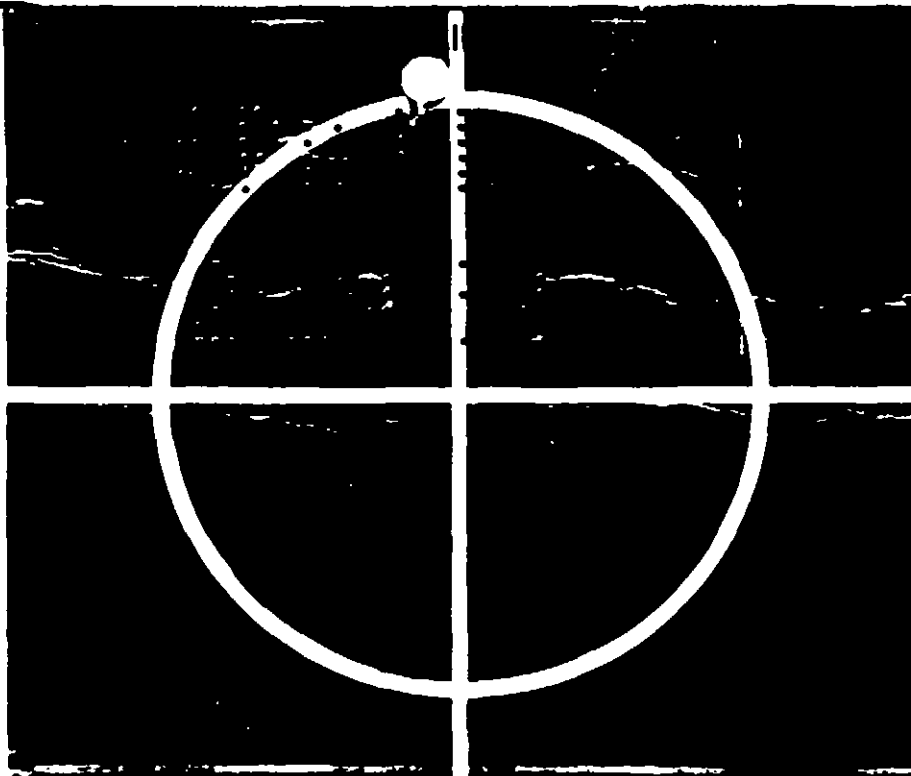

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

Read entire label. Use strictly in accordance with label warnings and directions.

Do not use on food crops. Break cartridge on score line only when necessary, and only when wearing rubber gloves. Never place more than one Systemic Insecticide Cartridge in chamber when using a feeder with Fertilizer Cartridges.

Use Systemic Insecticide Cartridges in conjunction with ROSS Fertilizer Cartridges. Make first application in early spring when new growth appears. Repeat applications every six weeks, if necessary,

through mid-summer. Using the ROSS Root Feeder connected to garden hose, treat plants up to three feet high or wide with cartridge. Treat with 1 additional cartridge for every foot over three. Example: a 6-ft. tree needs 2 cartridges; a 12-ft. tree needs 4 cartridges. Plan ahead to evenly disperse cartridges around outermost branches.

Use a gentle flow of water.

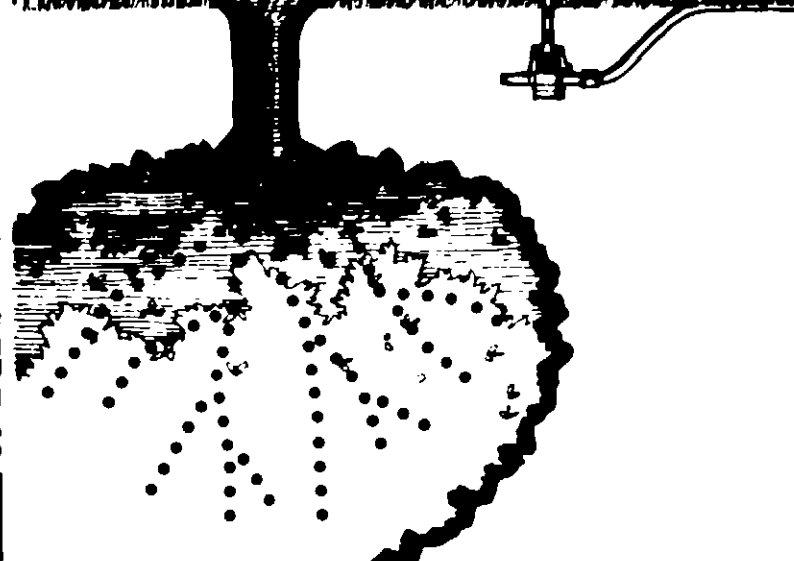
TREES, EVERGREEN TREES: Insert feeder tube into mulch zone under outer branches, to full depth and dispense cartridges.

ROSES, SHRUBS, EVERGREEN SHRUBS: Insert feeder tube up to 12 to 14 inches in ground and dispense cartridges. For shallow rooted plants, do not insert as deep but no less than six inches.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water or food or feed by storage or disposal. Store unused cartridges in original packaging. Always replace cap on vial after opening. DO NOT REUSE EMPTY VIALS FOR ANY PURPOSE. WRAP VIALS AND PUT IN TRASH COLLECTION.

Notice: This package is to be sold as a unit, and the contents within may not be sold separately.
Use as directed to control aphids (plant lice), birch leaf miners, holly leaf miners, lace bugs, leafhoppers, mimosa webworms, pin tip moths, spider mites, thrips and whiteflies.
ROSS Root Feeder Insecticide is a systemic action that protects plants from within. The insecticide is delivered in solution directly to the root zone, providing protection for trees, shrubs, evergreens and roses against sucking and mining insects. The insecticide is specially formulated to protect plants from within.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician. Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give

anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

This product contains an organic phosphate insecticide which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not contaminate water, food or feed. Avoid contamination of public and private water supplies by using anti-backflow siphonage equipment...a standard feature of the ROSS Root Feeder.

WARNING

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.
