

Unique 4-Way Action for the Hospital Carpet Fiber

- 1. BACTERIAL COUNT REDUCTION ACTIVITY | Sanitizes the carpet fiber effects a 99% + plus reduction in the number of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria.
- 2. FUNGISTATIC ACTIVITY & Inhibits the growth on the carpet fiber of infectious fungi in the presence of moisture.
- 3. BACTERIOSTATIC ACTIVITY : Inhibits the multiplication of bacteria on the carpet fiber in the presence of moisture.
- 4. ANTISTATIC ACTIVITY | Limits the electrostatic attraction of the fiber for air-borne and shoe-borne pathogens; also promotes a maximum release of static-held micro-organisms from carpet fiber to the vacuum cleaner.

ANTIDOTES AND OTHER PRECAUTIONS

DANGER:

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid breathing spray mist.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
