PURPOSE

Laundering: Bleaches and sanitizes colorfast or white cotton, linen, nylon, dacron or orlon. Will not harm machine or septic tank.

To Whiten nylon, dacron or orlon that has turned grey.

Stains: To remove fruit wine, tea, coffee, grass, ink, grease, etc. Also SCORCH and MILDEW.

Kitchen - Bathrooms: To clean, disinfect and remove stains from tile, porcelain, enamelware and linoleum floors.

Refrigerators: To clean, disinfect and to deodorize.

Toilet Bowls: To clean, remove stains and deodorize.

Drain Pipes: To clean and deodorize.

Special Disinfectant: Drapers, baby clothes, dish cloths, handkerchiefs and sickroom supplies.

General Disinfectant: Dairy and farm equipment, restaurant counters, etc.

Swimming Pools: bleach may be used to make pool water hygienically clean.

AMOUNT TO USE

2 tablespoons bleach
2 gallons water, or 1
cup bleach for each
machine load.

2 tablespoons bleach
1 gallon warm water

3 tablespoons bleach
1 quart cold water

2 tablespoons bleach
1 quart water

3 tablespoons bleach
1 quart warm water

1/2 cup bleach

1 cup bleach

3 tablespoons bleach
1 quart water

6 tablespoons bleach
2 gallons water

Use 28 oz. (3 1/2 cups)
of bleach to each
10,000 gallons of new
water.

DIRECTIONS

Add bleach to soaking, washing, or first rinse. Mix well. If bleach is added after clothes are in machine, dilute in 1 quart water before using.

Soak clean fabrics in solution 15 to 30 minutes. Rinse. Repeat if necessary.

Soak fabric in bleach solution 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse well.

Use in plain or suds water. Let stand wet 2 minutes. Rinse. Dry.

Wash inside. Keep with with bleach solution for 5 minutes. Rinse. Dry.

Pour bleach into bowl. Swish inside. Let stand hour or overnight.

Pour boiling water into drain. Follow with undiluted bleach.

Wash clean. Place in solution or keep wet 5 minutes. Rinse.

Wash clean. Place in solution or keep wet 2 minutes. Solution recommended by many Public Health Departments.

Thoroughly mix bleach in 20 parts of water and feed solution through a chlorinator or dilute and scatter over surface of pool. Test water frequently and add bleach as required to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 P.P.M. available chlorine. This bleach will not harm plants or fish.

CAUTION: DO NOT USE BLEACH WITH AMMONIA OR TOILET BOWL CLEANERS

This product may cause severe eye and skin irritation. Flood and rinse immediately with plenty of water. If taken internally, drink milk, white of egg or feed cooked cereal. Call a Physician.
