

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION:

Flammable liquid. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eye, flush with plenty of water and get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feed stuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas. At the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be cleaned during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Combustible under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or damage container. Exposure to temperatures above 120° F may cause boiling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This product kills: Flea, Mosquito, Bed-Carpet Beetles, Ants, Roaches, Cockroaches, Fleas, Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Spiders, Centipedes, Fleas, Ticks, Wasps, Pet Bugs, Crickets and Silverfish.

Ants in control of house do not kill.

Other exposed food dishes and food handling equipment, over cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Seal off holes and air conditioners. Put out air hoses.

Clos doors and windows. Hold valve opening away

from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each

5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of air is not assured.

Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE SPRAYING

TO OPERATE VALVE: Close valve. Open pressure for automatic discharge press valve button in the way it is holding the can. Then place fogger in stand upright in center of room with valve end down, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave burning oil once and keep building closed for four hours before using. Open all doors and windows and oil for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To air-tight. Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Apply this product to all other insects. Put fresh bedding in pet areas after treatment. Test dogs and cats with a ring test and control product before exposing them to enter.

Test 1: Fleas. Follow directions for flea. But use one unit per 50 cubic feet of room space.
