The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, add places to the percentage figures in the piperonyl butoxide substatement as follows: 0.12 and 0.03 percent, respectively.

The revised basic formulation dated June 5, 1990 is acceptable and has been included in our files for this pesticide. The proposed formula dated August 8, 1990 cannot be considered until you have supplied appropriate nitrosamine data to support the revision. You must analyze fresh production and formulation stored 3 months using containers and storage conditions representative of commercial operations.
