The labelling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1. The efficacy data submitted to support the mothproofing claim is acceptable. The high mortality of adults exposed to aged cloth for 2 to 7 days gives adequate assurance of the long-term protection offered against this fabric pest by a single application. Retreatment at 6-month intervals should suffice.
- 2. Revised the Storage and Disposal statement to read as follows:

"Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Replace cap before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture container."

3. Revised the "Physical and Chemical Hazards" statement to read as follows:

"Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting."

4. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person in unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing separately. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with prenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
