CONTROLS MOTHS, ROACHES, CARPET BEETLES, SILVERFISH, BEDBUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, WASPS and most other insects that can damage clothing and other fabrics.

STOP. READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Remove protective cap. Hold container upright and aim opening away from people. Push button down to spray. Keep nozzle at least 36 inches from surfaces or fabrics to avoid possible staining. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

MOTH PROOFING • Clothing and Blankets should be dry cleaned or washed before treating. Hold the container 14 - 18 inches from fabric and apply spray while moving evenly in a forward and back motion across the fabric while covering one foot per second. Spray fabric surface until it is slightly moist or damp to the touch. When possible treat both sides of fabric. For maximum protection place treated fabrics after drying in plastic or paper bags. **Carpets, Rugs and Draperies** should be cleaned by thoroughly brushing before treating. Treat as in directions for Clothing and Blankets.

SPECIAL NOTES: Prior to use, be sure to test for staining on delicate or expensive fabrics by applying to inconspicuous area. **Closets:** Also treat cracks and crevices of closets, chests and trunks where these fabrics are being stored. Treat the cracks and crevices at the rate of two seconds per linear foot. When applied as directed on fabric and in storage areas this treatment will offer protection for 6 months. To insure protection inspect the fabric in the storage area once every three months. Repeat application only when necessary. Avoid heavy applications. When possible make applications outdoors. If application is made indoors do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is complete.

INDOORS - FOR FLYING INSECTS • Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps and Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 - 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep can in constant motion. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Indian Meal Moths and Angoumois Grain Moths:** Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 - 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat applications weekly or as needed.

INDOORS - FOR CRAWLING INSECTS • Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Centipedes and Sowbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils and Grain Mites:** Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 - 60 minutes after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. **Carpet Beetles:** Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary. *Note: Check carpet manufacturer's*

warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting. **Bedbugs:** Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Fleas:** Spray sleeping quarters, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Repeat as necessary. *Use only a recommended pet spray on pets*

OUTDOORS • Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. **For the Control of Garden Insects:** For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese beetles hit by spray, as well as aphids, exposed thrips and spider mites. May be used on plants, as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas. When treating plants, do not spray closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one-second bursts. *Do not wet foliage or blossoms.*

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL • Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Replace cap before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture container.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray or contact with eyes or skin. Wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not spray closer than 18 inches from plants. Do not use near fishbowls or aquariums.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a Physician or Poison Control center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. **If on Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing separately. Get medical attention. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Removed victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
