To Kill Fleas & Ticks on Dogs and Cats: Apply directly to animals along back, underforelegs, and other areas except scrotum and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat within 24 hours of first treatment, if necessary. NOTE: This aerosol may make a slight hissing sound and cause a temporary cooling sensation. Hold get securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used but soon become accustomed to the treatment. To Kill Flear & Ticks in Pet Bedding and Pet Areas: To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting places until surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 Inches. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. - Part animal's hair to contact skin and insure good coverage.

- Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs, and other areas except scrotum and anus. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animat.
- 4. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist.
- 5. Repeat within 24 hours of first treatment, if necessary.

- Hold can 12" to 18" away from surface and spray until surface is slightly moist.
- Spray thoroughly into cracks and crevices in walls and floors, along baseboards, windows, and door frames.
- 4. Repeat treatment as necessary.
