Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. *Do not reapply product for 7 days. Do not use on cats or dogs under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.* **NOTE:** This aerosol may make a slight hissing sound and cause a temporary cooling sensation. Hold pet securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used but soon become accustomed to the treatment. **To Kill Fleas & Ticks in Pet Bedding and Pet areas:** To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animals bedding and other resting places until surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of 2 seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. **To Treat Flea & Tick Infestation in Rugs and Carpets:** Spray rugs and carpets where fleas tend to hide. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, in walls and floors, along baseboards,

windows and door frames. Repeat as necessary. *Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.*

OPTION B – NUMBERED FORMAT

To Kill Fleas & Ticks on Dogs and Cats

1. Part animal's hair to contact skin and insure good coverage.
2. Hold can about 12" away from pet while spraying.
3. Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs, and other areas except scrotum and anus. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal.
4. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist.

Do not reapply product for 7 days. Do not use on cats or dogs under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. **NOTE:** This aerosol may make a slight hissing sound and cause a temporary cooling sensation. Hold pet securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used but soon become accustomed to the treatment.

To Kill Fleas And Ticks in Pet Bedding and Around the Home

1. Treat areas where fleas and ticks tend to hide including pet bedding and resting areas, rugs and carpets, and inside surfaces of dog houses.
2. Hold can 12" to 18" away from surface and spray until surface is slightly moist.
3. Spray thoroughly into cracks and crevices in walls and floors, along baseboards, windows, and door frames.
4. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Note: If product is used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information
