The revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your files.

- 1. At the present time, we are willing to accept the use of the phrase, "Time Release Capsules" on your product labeling. However, subject to review in the future, we may ask you to remove this phrase.
- 2. In the Environmental Hazards section, you may delete the sentence which is stated as "Drift and...adjacent waters."
- 3. The deletion of the phrase, "Do not contaminate ... equipment washwaters" is acceptable as long as this product remains a ready to use aerosol product.
- 4. In the "Note to Physician" statement, please add the word "used" between the words, "be" and "as."

The comments listed above must be incorporated on the label before it is released for shipment.
