On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) since you have agreed to:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) or FIFRA sec. 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. If necessary, conduct any replacement studies or revise current precautionary statements (your letter dated July 11, 1991) when the Agency completes its precautionary labeling review of the Acute Dermal Toxicity Study.
3. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 9688-79."
 - b. Under Statement of Practical Treatment the IF ON SKIN statement should appear first.

c. **Revise Precautionary Statements as follows:**

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Nonfood/nonfeed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling).

d. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement, "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants," or submit an application to USDA requesting use in these areas. If granted, you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.

e. Delete ". . . including strains resistant to other insecticides" or submit efficacy data in support of the claim.

f. Delete "clean fresh scent." The terms "clean", "fresh" are considered vague non-specific terms implying unstated benefits and are unacceptable. Also as in our letter dated October 29, 1990 any fragrance claim is questionable with the deletion of Belle Air Fragrance 1008 from your product's formulation.

g. Delete "Super Fast Acting", and "No Lingering Odor". Vague or non-specific terms implying unstated benefits are not allowed.

h. Add the following precautions under the heading NOTE:

Do not apply this product in hospital patient rooms while occupied or in any rooms while occupied by the elderly or infirm.

i. Your labeling lists outdoor sites. Therefore you must the following "Environmental Hazards" statement:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water.

- j. The claim "Kills Hidden Bugs" is not acceptable and must be deleted. The claim implies that you do not have to spray areas such as cracks, crevices, etc. (areas listed in your directions).

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Chemsico Tralomethrin Insecticide A is a highly effective formulation which provides rapid kill of such crawling insects as listed below, including those resistant to certain other insecticides. In addition to rapid initial kill, Chemsico Tralomethrin Insecticide A stays on treated surfaces and provides residual insect killing power for up to three months after spray deposit has dried.

Directions for Use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label. Use strictly in accordance with label precautionary statements and directions.

HOW TO USE: Spray infested surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Point spray away from people, plants and pets. Do not introduce the spray into air or allow the spray to contact food or food contacting surfaces. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

DIRECTIONS: INDOORS - Within residential buildings including homes and apartments and within non-food areas of industrial, institutional and commercial buildings including hospitals, stores, manufacturing plants and warehouses for **SPOT TREATMENT** only. For control of Cockroaches, (including Asian and strains resistant to certain other insecticides), Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Firebrats, Silverfish and stored product insects (including adults and larvae) such as Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Indian Meal Moths, Rice Weevils, Mediterranean Flour Moths and Red Flour Moths. Direct spray into cracks and crevices in walls, dark corners of rooms, cabinets and closets, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, around plumbing and other utility installations, around waste containers, and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Residual activity lasts up to three months. For control of Carpet Beetles, spray along baseboard and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelves and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected. For control of Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks, spray infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, windows and door frames; apply to localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present. Test inconspicuous sample of fabric or rug for staining before use. Old bedding of pets should be removed and cleaned or replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. Do not treat pets with this product. To control the source of flea infestation, pet inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for animal application.

OUTDOORS: (For use only in reducing annoyance from these insects) Fleas, Mosquitoes - Spray outside-surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also spray
