- c. Under "Fleas, Brown Dog and..." section, add the following precautionary statement:

Not recommended for use on puppies and kittens less than 4 weeks old. Do not use this product on old sick or debilitated animals.

- d. In the ingredient statement, correct the chemical spelling of Permethrin as "...-2,2-dimethyl...".
- e. Either delete the phrase "Clean Fresh Scent" or identify the type of scent i.e, pine, floral etc.
- f. Following instruction for Bedbugs, Carpet Beetles and Clothes Moths, add the following precaution: "Allow treated articles to thoroughly dry before use."
- g. With respect to the instructions for Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Bee Control, there is no indication as to the extension of the spray stream which is delivered from the hand "trigger" sprayer or the "protective distance" an applicator must stand to deliver the product. Please include in the application directions appropriate precautions to clarify applicator use.

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

For Household Use Only: For use in rooms, apartments, homes, attics, basements, campers, boats, household storage areas, garages, pet sleeping areas, cabins.

Directions for Use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Pest Indoors: Continue to kill and protect for up to 4 weeks with no lingering oily odor. For residual and contact control of cockroaches (waterbugs), crickets, silverfish (firebrats), clover mites, millipedes, centipedes, earwigs, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders, brown dog ticks, lone star ticks, ants, clothes moths, carpet beetles, fleas, boxelder bugs, scorpions, spider beetles, bedbugs, grasshoppers, house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, fruit flies, cluster flies, flying moths, confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles, grain mites, red flour beetles, angoumois grain moths, grain weevils, Indian meal moths, Mediterranean flour moths, lesser grain borers, cigarette beetles, drug store beetles, chocolate moths. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, storage areas, doorways, window openings and wherever insects may enter the home. Spray directly on insects where possible.

For Bedbugs: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices, around baseboards, floorboards, bedboards and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may harbor bedbugs, concentrating on tufts, folds and seams. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestations, consult professional applicator. **Grain Insects:** To control confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, spider beetles, shiny spider beetles, grain mites, red flour beetles, angoumois grain moths, grain weevils, Indian meal moths, Mediterranean flour moths, lesser grain borers, cigarette beetles, drug store beetles, chocolate moths, carpet beetles-remove infested grain, cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the area by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. In homes, dispose of all infested products. The shelves and drawers should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed so as to contact all pests, and cover with shelf paper after allowing shelves to dry. Any utensils that are contacted with spray should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary. **Spiders:** Spray directly on spiders and their webs. Spray all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders. Repeat as necessary. **Ants:** To kill ants, spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray directly on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. **Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Bees:** Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, especially under attic rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. **Fleas, Brown Dog and Lone Star Ticks on Dogs, Cats and Premises:** Spray animals along back, under limbs and on other areas, except scrotum, face and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold sprayer about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes, mouth or nose of animal. To prevent reinfection, thoroughly spray the animals' bedding and other resting areas around the home including carpets until the surface is slightly moist contacting as many insects as possible. Treat the floor area, cracks and crevices in the floor and along baseboards at the rate of 2 seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 14 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. **House Flies, Mosquitoes, Cluster Flies, Gnats, Fruit Flies, Flying Moths:** Close off all doors and windows. Point sprayer upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which may attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed. **Carpet Beetles and Clothes Moths:** To treat carpets-hold container 14-18 inches from carpet. Apply spray evenly, covering the entire surface until slightly moist. Spray underside of carpet when possible. Avoid wetting or soaking. **NOTE:** Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and

Also, apply to buildings, including porches, screening refuse dumps, and other areas where pests are likely to enter. Repeat treatment as needed to maintain control. **House Flies, Mosquitoes, Cluster Flies, Gnats:** outdoor use only as an aid in reducing pest populations on outside surfaces of screens, doors, windows, and other places where these insects enter the room.
