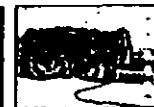

### HOW TO USE

1. Shake bottle before using.



2. Decide the dilution rate you need based on the type of weeds you want to kill. The dilution rate is the number of parts of concentrate to mix with each gallon of water.

#### Weed Types

**EASY TO KILL:** such as ajuga, black medic, morning glory, oxalis, plantain (broadleaf, lance)

**HARDER TO KILL:** such as barnyard grass, foxtail, ground ivy, knotweed, portulaca, spotted

**HARDEST TO KILL:** such as crabgrass (smooth, goosegrass, quackgrass)

Some hard to kill weeds may require retreatment.

3. Choose an application method:

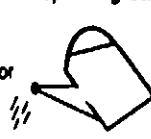
Tank Sprayer

Mix concentrate with water to the desired dilution rate.

5. Weeding and mowing will begin within hours.



### USE TIPS

- For best results, apply on a sunny day when it's above 60° F. If it rains within 24 hours of spraying, you'll probably need to re-spray.
- Don't spray on plants you like to keep. Don't spray on windy days. Rinse them off with water if you do.
- Use higher concentrations (up to 10 2/3 gallons) on hard-to-kill weeds and tough grasses.
- Wash sprayer container thoroughly after use.

### HOW IT WORKS

Chemisco Grass & Weed Killer A concentrate works only if it contacts the foliage of unwanted vegetation. Once it hits the ground, it is deactivated by the soil.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
