For total weed control on certain areas around the home. Use for bare ground vegetation control in driveways, brick walks, paths, patios, along fences and curbs, around buildings, and under graveled pathways where plant growth has come through these surfaces. Controls bindweed, common mullein, and other hard-to-kill weeds. Prevents plant growth for up to one year.

This product is a non-selective vegetation killer intended for use after diluting with water, or an appropriate oil*.

For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting. Weeds taller than 4-6 inches should be hoed before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application. A second application may be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds.

STOP. READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO APPLY

For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds such as downy brome grass, oatgrass, goosegrass, quackgrass, puncturevine, goldenrod, and plantain. To cover 100 sq. ft., apply 1 pint in 2 gallons of water by using a sprinkling can or other watering or spraying device.

For control of hard-to-kill perennial broadleaf and grass weeds such as bindweed and johnsongrass as well as the biennials common mullein and wild carrot, use 2 quart (1/2 gallon) in 2 gallons of water.

*Different grades of mineral oil, diesel fuel, petroleum-based oil or kerosene may be substituted for water.

When using sprinkling can, rinse three times and pour rinse water on treated area once application is completed. Mix only the quantity needed and use immediately. Do not store dilute solution once container is opened. To minimize spread to untreated areas, gently water in immediately after application.

PRECAUTIONS: (1) Keep people and pets off treated areas until these areas are dry. (2) Apply when air is calm to avoid the possibility of drift onto near by plants or grass. (3) Keep away from the roots of desirable plants and trees. (4) Avoid using where adjacent trees, shrubs, or plants may be injured from leaching of the chemical through the soil. (5) Do not use on slopes or in areas where run-off is likely to occur (apply

only to level areas). (6) Use for control of all vegetation is not to be used on cultivated, or shrubs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container for trash collection.
