THINGS TO KNOW

For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting. Weeds tailer than 4-6 inches should be mowed or hoed before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application. A second application may also be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds,

HOW TO APPLY

Select the dilution rate you need based on type of weeds you want to kill (see the following chart). Using a sprinkler can, evenly wet soil and existing weeds. If soil is dry, water before treatment. Use only where complete kill of all vegetation is wanted. Do not apply closer than twice the distance of the drip . line from the trunk of trees or plants, (Using a graphic to help illustrate this concept.) Do not treat along fences if desirable plants are growing or if future plantings are planned. This product will harm desirable plants if touched by the mist or by leaching of the chemical through the ground. Do not apply on slopes because of possible chemical leaching through the soil.
