### OPTIONAL MARKETING LANGUAGE

#### OPTION A

[For total weed control on certain areas around the home. Use for bare ground vegetation control in driveways, [brick] walks and paths, patios, along fences and curbs, around buildings, and under graveled pathways where plant growth has come through those surfaces. Controls bindweed, common mullein, and other hard-to-kill weeds. *Prevents plant growth for up to one year.*]

#### OPTION B

[Kills vegetation and prevents plant growth for up to one year. Use only where no plant growth is wanted like driveways, cracks in walks, gravel paths, along fences, patios, curbs, gutters and parking areas. Controls bindweed, common mullein and other hard-to-kill weeds.]

**DO NOT USE ON LAWNS, FLOWERS OR VEGETABLE GARDENS, OVER TREE ROOTS OR AREAS WHERE PLANTINGS ARE PLANNED.** Do not apply over the roots of desirable plants.

This product is a non-selective vegetation killer intended for use after diluting with water.

### STOP. READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. *For outdoor use around the home only.*



Keep people and pets off treated areas until these areas are dry.

#### THINGS TO KNOW

For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting. Weeds taller than 4-6 inches should be mowed or hoed before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application. A second application may also be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds.

### HOW TO APPLY

Select the dilution rate you need based on type of weeds you want to kill (see the following chart). Using a sprinkler can, evenly wet soil and existing weeds. If soil is dry, water before treatment. Use only where complete kill of all vegetation is wanted. Do not apply closer than twice the distance of the drip line from the trunk of trees or plants. (Using a graphic to help illustrate this concept.) Do not treat along fences if desirable plants are growing or if future plantings are planned. This product will harm desirable plants if touched by the mist or by leaching of the chemical through the ground. Do not apply on slopes because of possible chemical leaching through the soil.

DILUTION TABLE TO COVER 100 SQ. FT.	
WEED TYPE	RATE
<i>Easier to Kill Weeds</i> such as downy brome-grass, oatgrass, goosegrass, quack-grass, puncturevine, goldenrod and plantain.	1 pt. in 2 gals. of water
<i>Hard to Kill Weeds</i> such as bindweed and Johnsongrass, common mullein and wild carrot	2 qts. in 2 gals. of water

Mix up only enough product needed to cover the area to be treated. Do not store diluted mixture. To minimize spread to untreated areas, gently water in immediately after application. Stop before run-off occurs.

#### CLEANING UP

When done treating, clean out your sprinkler can by rinsing three times with water. Apply the rinse water to the treated area.

**PRECAUTIONS:** (1) Apply when air is calm to avoid the possibility of drift onto nearby plants or grass. (2) Keep away from the roots of desirable plants and trees. (3) Avoid using where adjacent trees, shrubs, or plants may be injured from leaching of the chemical through the soil.
