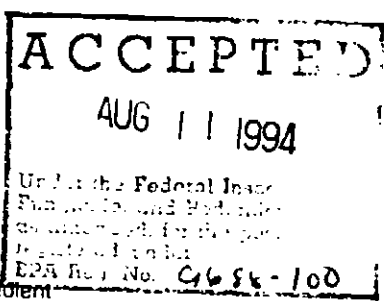

For total weed control on certain areas around the home. Use for bare ground vegetation control in driveways, brick walks, paths, patios, along fences and curbs, around buildings, and under graveled pathways where plant growth has come through these surfaces. Controls bindweed, common mullein, and other hard-to-kill weeds. Prevents plant growth for up to one year.

This product is a ready-to-use non-selective vegetation killer. Do not dilute.

For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting. Weeds taller than 4-6 inches should be hoed before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application. A second application may be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds.

STOP. READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO APPLY

Remove cap from sprinkler applicator. Make sure that the sprinkler applicator is screwed firmly on the bottle. Invert bottle and apply product to thoroughly cover unwanted vegetation. The width of the pattern may be adjusted by either raising or lowering the bottle. Hold the bottle about 2 to 6 inches from the area to be treated depending upon desired width. To minimize spread of product to untreated areas, gently water in immediately after application.

AMOUNT TO USE

For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds such as downy brome grass, oatgrass, goosegrass, quackgrass, puncturevine, goldenrod, and plantain, use 1 quart to cover 100 sq. ft.

For control of hard-to-kill perennial broadleaf and grass weeds such as bindweed and johnsongrass as well as the biennials common mullein and wild carrot, use 4 quarts (1 gallon) for each 100 sq. ft.

PRECAUTIONS: (1) Keep people and pets off treated areas until these areas are dry. (2) Apply when air is calm to avoid the possibility of drift onto nearby plants or grass. (3) Keep away from the roots of desirable plants and trees. (4) Avoid using where adjacent trees, shrubs, or plants may be injured from leaching of the chemical through the soil. (5) Do not use

on slopes or in areas where wind may drift (apply only to level areas). (6) Do not use for control of all vegetation. Do not be used on cultivated areas, greenhouses, or shrubs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of container by trash collection.
