Enclosed please find our Notification to add two marketing phrases to our current approved label for the subject product. The first phrase is "NEW", which we understand can be printed on the label only for a limited time; based on your previous approvals, we will use the phrase only for six months. The second phrase is "Non-staining*" with the qualifying footnote "**NOTE: Prior to use, be sure to test for staining on delicate or expensive fabrics by applying to an inconspicuous area.*"
