WEED TYPES	DILUTION RATE
EASY TO KILL: such as ajuga, black medic, dandelion, morning glory, oxalis, plantain (broadleaf, lanceleaf)	3 - 5 oz./gal. water
HARDER TO KILL: such as ground ivy, knotweed, portulaca, spotted spurge	6 - 8 oz./gal. water
HARDEST TO KILL: such as barnyard grass, bermudagrass, blue grass (annual, perennial), crabgrass (smooth, large), foxtail (green, yellow), goosegrass, Johnson grass (seedling), quackgrass, ryegrass (annual)	9 - 12 oz./gal. water

HOW TO APPLY

1. SHAKE WELL (graphic).
2. Select the dilution rate you need based on the types of grasses or weeds you want to kill. The dilution rate is the number of ounces of concentrate to mix with each gallon of water.
3. Choose an application method: Pressure Sprayer • Trigger Sprayer • Sprinkling Can
Mix concentrate with water to the desired dilution rate.
4. Thoroughly wet the weeds or grass you want to kill.
5. Wilting and browning will begin within hours.

USE TIPS

1. For best results, apply on a sunny day when it's above 60°F. If it rains within 12 hours of spraying, retreatment may be necessary.
2. Don't spray on desirable plants - this product will kill them too. Also, don't spray on windy days to avoid drift to desirable plants. Rinse them off immediately if contact occurs.
3. Treated areas may be replanted in 48 hours.
4. Use higher concentrations (up to 12 ounces per gallon) for tough grasses such as Bermuda and Annual Bluegrass; Some hard-to-kill weeds may require more than one application.
