Dear Mr. Metzger:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

- 1. Remove the following claim as it implies the product possesses special qualities due to its 'unique' composition, which is false and misleading:
 - "Its [Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer Z's] unique formula is absorbed into grassy weeds and travels to the roots, killing the entire plant-roots and all.
- 2. Remove the following claims or submit environmental fate studies for their support: "It works only when it contacts foliage and is deactivated when it hits the soil, making it ideal for use around flowers, shrubs and trees."
 - "Once it hits the ground, it is deactivated by the soil so it is ideal for use around shrubs, flower beds, and tree wells."
- 3. Remove the following claim as it is overly broad: "Kills grassy weeds fast-roots and all."

4. Per the Label Review Manuel, revise all "Pesticide Disposal" subheadings to read "Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling."

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this letter or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones.

HOW TO APPLY

(OPTION A: Hand Sprayer Applicator)

- 1. SHAKE WELL (graphic).
- 2. CONNECT TRIGGER SPRAYER. Unscrew and discard the [white] cap on the bottle. Insert the hose into the bottle and tighten the cap securely.
- PRIME SPRAYER. Turn the sprayer nozzle one-half turn counter-clockwise.
 Hold the sprayer lower than the bottle and squeeze the trigger several times until it sprays. Adjust the nozzle to coarse spray pattern. Avoid sprays which are too fine because they can drift and damage other plants.
- 4. SPRAY UNWANTED GRASS & WEEDS UNTIL COMPLETELY COVERED. Wilting and browning will begin within hours.

(OPTION B: Trigger Sprayer Applicator)

- 1. SHAKE WELL (graphic).
- 2. Turn the nozzle to coarse spray pattern. Avoid sprays which are too fine because they can drift and damage other plants.
- 3. SPRAY UNWANTED GRASS & WEEDS UNTIL COMPLETELY COVERED. Wilting and browning will begin within hours.

(OPTION C: Sprinkler Cap Applicator)

- 1. SHAKE WELL (graphic).
- Remove cap from sprinkler head. Make sure that the sprinkler head is screwed firmly onto bottle. The width of the pattern can be adjusted by raising or lowering the bottle.
- 3. INVERT BOTTLE AND WET UNWANTED GRASS & WEEDS COMPLETELY. Wilting and browning will begin within hours.

USE TIPS

- 1. For best results, apply on a sunny day when it's above 60° F. If it rains within 12 hours of spraying, retreatment may be necessary.
- Don't spray on desirable plants this product will kill them too. Also, don't spray
 on windy days to avoid drift to desirable plants. Rinse them off immediately if
 contact occurs. [ALTERNATE: Don't spray on windy days to avoid drift to
 desirable plants. If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse immediately
 with water.]
- 3. Treated areas may be replanted in 48 hours.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Only persons applying this product may be in the area during application.

(Graphics with call outs.)

- 1. CONNECT WAND HOSE TO POWER PUMP BOTTLE. Unwrap the wand. Unscrew and discard the [Black] cap protecting the bottle opening. (graphic). Push the clear tube down through the small opening on the bottle. Tightly screw the [Green] hose connector cap onto the bottle. (graphic). Make sure the [Green] button on the wand is "OFF" or "UP" before pressurizing (graphic).
- 2. PRESSURIZE THE POWER PUMP. Break off the Pump Handle "TAB" with your thumb (graphic). Pump 20-30 times to build up pressure. NOTE: The Power Pump bottle may bulge slightly as it is pressurized. Never pressurize by any means other than the pump included. You'll need to pump every once in a while to keep the Power Pump pressurized during use.
- 3. SPRAY WEEDS AND UNWANTED GRASS! Just depress the [Green] button on the wand to spray. If needed, the button can be locked "ON" by pushing it down and forward at the same time. The reverse motion will lock it "OFF" (graphic).
 - Spray unwanted grass or weeds until wet.
- 4. WILTING OR BROWNING WILL BEGIN IN HOURS. (graphic)

USE TIPS

- 1. For best results, apply on a sunny day when it's above 60° F. If it rains within 12 hours of spraying, retreatment may be necessary.
- 2. Don't spray on windy days to avoid drift to desirable plants, if desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse immediately with water.
- Treated areas may be replanted in 48 hours.

REFILLING

The Power Pump can be refilled up to 5 times with Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer Z or Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer M [concentrate]. When using the concentrate, add 12.8 ozs. of product and dilute to a gallon with water. Use the "Fill-to-Here" mark on the side of the Power Pump bottle as a guide. Make sure the [Green] pump cap and the [Black] hose connector cap are tightly secured before repressurizing.

IMPORTANT: Do not refill more than 5 times. Do not use any product other than Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer Z or Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer M [concentrate] in this Power Pump. Incompatible chemicals may damage the pump making it unsafe to use.

OPTION E: PRESSURIZED SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS


PRESSURIZED SPRAYER DIRECTIONS

1. Pressurize Sprayer

Before use, bend or break off shipping safety "tabs" located on each side of the pump rod. Attach spray hose to bottle by turning hose connection cap to the right. Make certain the connection is secure. Align locking bar on pump handle with slots on top of pump to release handle for pumping. Pump 10-20 times for maximum pressure. Fewer pumps may be desirable to control spray in tight areas. Pump occasionally during application to maintain tank pressure and desired spray pattern. Do not over pressurize.

2. Spraying

Position deflector shield on top of nozzle outlet for a fine fan spray to cover wider areas: rotate to bottom of nozzle outlet for a more precise, solid stream.

Depress button to begin spraying. Slide button forward to lock on; press down and back to release to off.

Refilling Sprayer

The sprayer can be refilled up to 5 times with Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer Z or Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer M [concentrate]. Before opening, release any built-up pressure by opening valve. Press down on pump handle and turn to left to remove pump assembly from tank. Add 12.8 oz. and dilute to a gallon with water. Use "Fill to Here" mark on the side of the bottle as a guide. Shake well to mix. Replace pump, turning to right to seal.

IMPORTANT: Do not refill more than 5 times. To keep track of the number of times refilled, put a mark through the appropriate number.]

5 Final

Do not use any product other than Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer Z or Chemsico Grass & Weed Killer M [concentrate] in the sprayer. Incompatible chemicals may change the pump making it unsafe to use.

Cleaning/Maintaining Sprayer

Between uses, release pressure as described above. Detach sprayer hose from tank by turning hose connection cap to left. Lock on sprayer nozzle, hold end of hose under running water, and let clean water run through hose for 1-2 minutes. Drain water from hose, reattach to sprayer and place handle in built-in storage pocket. Apply a few drops of oil to pump rod, then pump several times to lubricate the rod. Store container in a cool, dark place between uses.

Sprayer Precautions

- Always thoroughly inspect your sprayer before each use.
- Be sure hose is securely attached and in good condition before pressurizing
- Discard if any worn or damaged parts are noticed.
- Do not allow spray to reach people or animals.
- Always release air pressure before removing pump (see sprayer directions).
- Do not use this sprayer to apply any materials other than Chemsico Lawn and Garden Insect Control concentrate. Other materials could cause the container to weaken or corrode its working parts, which could lead to injury.
- Do not use mechanical devices to pressurize the tank. They can create excessive and dangerous pressure which could cause the tank to explode.
- Do not stand over pressurized sprayer while using or pumping it.
- Do not use solutions hotter than 105 [or appropriate temperature] degrees F.
- Always securely tighten the pump. An improperly tightened pump could be forcibly ejected and cause serious injury.
- Do not pressurize sprayer until ready to use. Do not store sprayer pressurized. or leave pressurized sprayer unattended.
- Do not lift or carry sprayer by hose or extension rod. Carry only by pump or bottle handle, making sure handle is properly locked in place before lifting.

- Do not force clogged nozzle open with air pressure. Clean with fine wire or toothpick.
- Failure to heed all precautions and directions could result in serious bodily injury or property damage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

(For options D & E - Power Pump and Pressurized Sprayer)

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Always release pressure by unscrewing the pump cap before storing. Pesticide Disposal: If empty: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container unless the directions for use allow a different (concentrated) product to be diluted in the container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

(All Application Methods)

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material.
