- 1. Insert the missing words in the last sentence of the oral First Aid statement so that it reads: "Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."
- 2. Add the word "eye" at the end of the second sentence of the ocular first aid statement so that it reads: "Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit one copy of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment.




