STOP

Keep people and pets off treated areas until dry.

1. Shake well.
2. Adjust nozzle to coarse spray pattern to minimize wind drift.
3. Spray just enough product to lightly cover broadleaf weeds. *Excessive spraying can injure some lawns.* Do not spray weeds growing within the dripline of trees. Do not apply when daytime temperatures are above 85° F as lawn injury can occur. Spray only the weeds, not the entire lawn.
4. Weeds will begin wilting and browning overnight.

- (1) Some hard-to-kill weeds may require re-treatment. Wait at least 3 weeks between applications - some weeds can take that long to die.
- (2) Rainproof - rain or watering 6 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness. If rainfall occurs within 6 hours of application, the product should be re-applied.
