Use Restrictions

- For surface spray: Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- For space spray: Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.
- Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the

treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed.

- Do not wet plants to point of runoff or drip.
- Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried.
- Dry clean treated clothes before wearing. {Only included when "To Control Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles" section is included on the label}
- Not for broadcast use on indoor residential surfaces.

{All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2ft. by 1 ft or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.

Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment."

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff

To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.}

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces or wash them before use. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Hold can upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

INDOORS

FLYING INSECTS: Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Hornets, Yellowjackets, Gnats, Skipper Flies and Small Flying Moths: Spray window sills, window and door frames and other indoor surfaces where these insects may land. Close all doors and windows and spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 - 10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Spiders, Scorpions, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Stink bugs, Boxelder bugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

Ants [including carpenter ants]:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpet.

To Control Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray for 5-10 seconds to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storage areas directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.

Fleas & Brown Dog Ticks (Adults and Larvae): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, paying special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture and mattresses may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

OUTDOORS

Point nozzle away from face. Hold can at slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Hornets, Yellowjackets, Gnats and Small Flying Moths. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants[including carpenter ants], Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, Stink bugs, Boxelder bugs and Silverfish.** Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

FOR THE CONTROL OF GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by spray, as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of the first signs of insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, Wandering Jews and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Armyworms. When spraying plants, do not spray closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90° F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

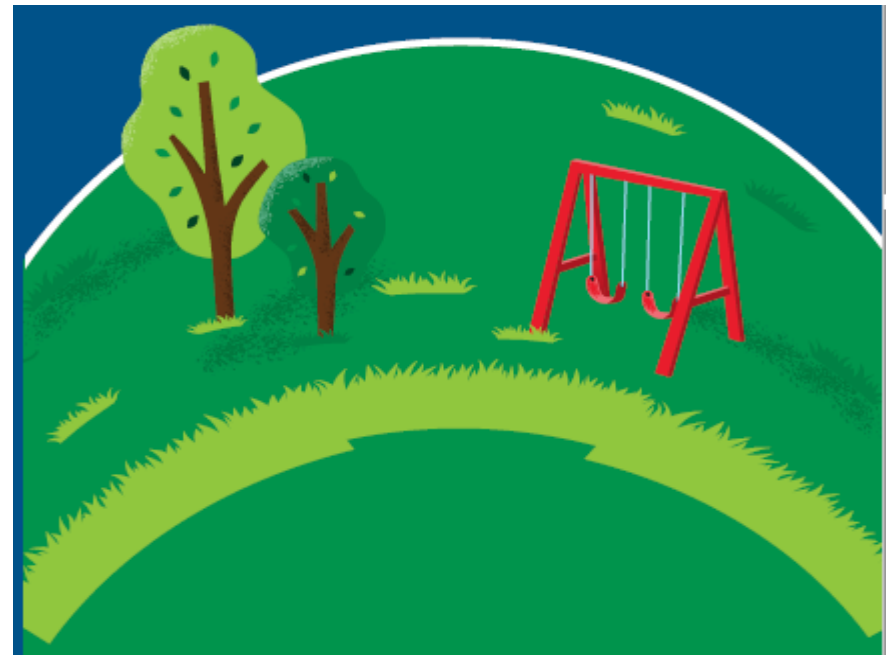
