STOPI READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. FOR HOUSEHOLD USE.

HOW TO USE: Shake well before using. Spray surfaces until wet, moving the spray rapidly to prevent excessive welling and waste of product. Point spray away from people, pets and plants. Do not use as a room spray. Do not allow the spray to contact food or food contacting surfaces. Thoroughly wash dishes, utensits and counter tops with soap and water if they are sprayed with this product. Do not allow people or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS: FOR SPOT TREATMENT ONLY - For control of Cockroaches, Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets. Firebrats, Silverfish and stored product insects (including adults and larvae) such as Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Indian Meal Moths, Rice Weevils, Mediterranean Flour Moths and Red Flour Moths, Direct spray into cracks and crevices in walls, dark corners of rooms, cabinets and closets, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, around plumbing and other utility installations, around waste containers and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Residual activity lasts up to two months. For control of Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks, spray injested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, wholew and door frames and localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present. Test inconspicuous sample of fabric or rug for staining before use. Old bedding of pets should be removed and cleaned or replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. Do not treat pets with this product. To control the source of flee intestations, treat your pet with a product registered for animal application (Optional: such as . . .). Also treat your yard with a product registered for yard application (Optional: such as . . .). For control of Carpet Baeties, spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelves and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected. Test inconspicuous sample of fabric or rug for staining before use. Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.

OUTDOORS (for use as an ald in reducing annoyance from these

insects) Files, Mosquitoes - Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate. Repeat as necessary. Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs - Thoroughly spray inlested weeds or bushy non-crop areas. For Ants, thoroughly wel hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture container.
