DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For household use.

All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

INDOORS

FLYING INSECTS: Files (House, Black, Fruit, Blow, Skipper) Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees and small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto bugs, Silverlish, Firebrats, Crickets, Carpet beetles, Scorplons, Bedbugs, Spiders, Clothes moths, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pilibugs: Spray Into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary. For ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. For carpet beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat as necessary. For bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat as necessary. To control clothes moths and carpet beetles on wool and other natural fibers: Remove Infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours In sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storage places directing the spray Into cracks, Joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles

may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

OUTDOORS

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can at a slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas including (but not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and trash containers. Repeat as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS: Files, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Homets and Yellow Jackets. Allow log to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, Including Aslan Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes and Silverlish. Spray Infested surface of patio or plonic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant trails and hills. Ants, Lone Star Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestations in bushes, grass or weeds. For Ants, Spray freely around ant trails and hills.

FOR CONTROL OF ORNAMENTAL GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beelles hit by spray, as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, Exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Lealminers.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatment of insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas. May also be used on other plants such as African Violets, asters, azaleas, begonlas, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering

Under the Federal Insecticide, Pungiside, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the posticide registered under EPA Reg. No. 12 K

Jews and zinnlas.

Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Army Worms. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion, Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90 ° F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture container.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist, in case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying or surface applications. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.
