The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Diquat Dibromide and Fluazifop-p-butyl Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. (OPTION B: Trigger Sprayer Applicator)

- 2. Turn the nozzle to coarse spray pattern. Avoid sprays which are too fine because they can drift and damage other plants.

- 2. Twist nozzle to adjust spray from CLOSE to SPRAY or STREAM. [Graphic depiction]
- 3. [When priming the sprayer, hold sprayer level to the ground. Sprayer may not prime if it is held at an angle. Once primed, it will spray in any direction.
- Aim toward target [site] [area to be treated], and away from people and pets.
- Press the trigger to spray.
- Release the trigger to stop spray.

USE TIPS

- 1. For best results, apply on a sunny day when it's above 60° F. If it rains within 12 hours of spraying, re-treatment may be necessary.
- 2. Don't spray on desirable plants this product will kill them too. Also, don't spray on windy days to avoid drift to desirable plants. Rinse them off immediately if contact occurs. {ALTERNATE:} [Don't spray on windy days to avoid drift to desirable plants. If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse immediately with water.]
- 3. Treated areas may be replanted in 48 hours.
